

What is a Tata Maintenance Plan?

The Maintenance Plan includes the replacement, maintenance or repair of specific wear-and-tear parts, when necessary.

The Maintenance Plan runs for a set period of time (e.g. 3 years) or for a fixed number of kilometres (e.g. 45 000 km), whichever happens first.

To ensure your plan stays intact, service your vehicle as per the Tata specifications at approved repair facilities.

*Maintenance plan upgrades do not pay for services provided for by your OEM plan or current existing plans.





What is wear and tear?

Wear and tear is a term used to describe the gradual physical deterioration of various parts of the vehicle. Wear and tear happens naturally and is inevitable as a result of normal use and ageing.

How do you benefit?

This plan includes Tata specified services and parts

- · Only qualified technicians who use genuine Tata parts will service your vehicle
- · Cost of the plan is added to your vehicle finance agreement and is paid as part of your monthly instalments
- 24/7 roadside assistance

What does a Tata Maintenance Plan provide for?

Service components

- Belts accessory belt, cambelt (only if specified in the Tata service schedule)
- Filters (oil, air, pollen, fuel)
- Oil & lubricants (engine, coolant, transmission, brake & clutch, differential)
- Spark plugs
- Sump plug gasket
- Tensioners & pulleys (only if specified in the Tata service schedule)
- Workshop consumables (maximum of R100.00 excl. VAT)

Note: Maintenance plan upgrades do not pay for services provided for by your OEM plan or current existing plans.

Maintenance components

Replaced on normal wear and tear as per Tata specifications

- Air conditioner (compressor only, regassing only on replacement)
- Alternator
- Battery
- Clutch and clutch components
- CV Joints and boots
- Differential Unit
- Engine
- Exhaust (excluding catalytic converters)
- Factory fitted door locks,
- · boot locks and electronic ignitions
- Front brake discs (replacement will be considered only if the component is outside Tata specification and skimming tolerance)
- Front brake pads (limitations apply)
- Front shock absorbers
- Fuel system, which includes the fuel pump

- Fuses and globes (excl. xenon and sealed units)
- Rear brake discs or drums (replacement will be considered only if the component is outside manufacturer specification and skimming tolerance)
- Rear brake pads or shoes (limitations apply)
- Rear wheel cylinders
- Rear shock absorbers
- Starter motor
- Steering components (steering rack, column and pump)
- Transmission/gearbox
- · Turbo assembly (sealed units)
- V-belts (only if deemed necessary by the approved repair facility)
- Water pump
- Wheel bearings
- Wiper blades (one set annually)

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Your vehicle qualifies for a Tata Maintenance Plan if it:

- · Has travelled less than 80 000 km
- Is less than 4 years old (calculated from the date of first registration)
