

What is Tyre and Rim Insurance?

Tyre and Rim Insurance provides cover for damage to your tyres and rims caused by punctures, blowouts, and road hazards like kerbs, potholes, and debris.

The policy pays for tyre or rim repairs or replacements, up to the stated limit and period.



Your vehicle qualifies for Tyre and Rim Insurance if it:

- Has comprehensive motor vehicle insurance cover
- Weighs less than 3 000 kg
- Is not older than 2 years and has travelled less than 40 000 km
- Is in a roadworthy condition.
 Subject to an inspection by an approved service provider.



Claims

For Tyre and Rim Cover claims, contact M-Sure on 0860 927 726 or email claims@m-sure.co.za. You must advise us within 7 days of the incident.

Cooling off period

If the policy has a duration of 31 days or more and if no benefits have been paid or claimed on an event insured against the policy, you have the right to cancel this policy within 14 days of the date of the receipt of the policy document.

Policy conditions

Cancellation of policy

You can cancel at any time by contacting M-Sure. Should the insurer wish to cancel, you will receive 31 days notice of cancellation.

Exclusions

- Taxis or hire vehicles, rebuilt vehicles (code 3), courier or delivery vehicles, modified vehicles (including turbo conversion), vehicles that are or have been, used in any form of motoring competition
- · Any manufacturer's defect, recall, dry rot or flat spot
- Your motor vehicle being driven on any beach, 4 wheel drive track or off-road
- Any damage caused by fire, theft or road accident
- · Any deliberate, intentional, malicious or criminal act, vandalism, misuse or abuse
- Any act of nature including but not limited to fire, thunderstorm, hail or flood
- · Failing to maintain the manufacturer's recommended tyre pressure

- Not taking all reasonable precautions to prevent loss or damage to your motor vehicle tyres and wheel rims, including:
 - Damage caused whilst the vehicle was being used for commercial purposes
 - Damage caused whilst testing in preparation for speed tests, or any form of racing, Motorsport, track day
 or time trial
 - · Tread depreciation, abnormal wear and tear, rust or corrosion of tyres and wheel rims
 - Damage that is the direct result of overloading your motor vehicle or your motorcycle beyond the limits specified by your vehicle's manufacturer
 - Tyres and wheel rims which are not roadworthy or have been fitted to a vehicle which is not roadworthy
 - Tyres and wheel rims that have been previously repaired, other than punctures
 - An unauthorised driver
 - · A driver who does not have a valid driver's license
 - A driver who is under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Racing tyres or wheel rims made for racing
- · Temporary or space saver wheels
- Re-treaded tyres
- Damage caused by scratching and bruising including side wall bubbles.
- Damage to the tyres which are covered by any other insurance policy
- Any costs or expenses not covered under this warranty and / or that can be recovered from your motor insurance policy
- Nuclear risks: Loss, damage or liability directly or indirectly caused by, or arising from, ionising radiation or radioactive contamination from any nuclear fuel or from any nuclear waste arising from burning nuclear fuel, or the radioactive, toxic, explosive or other dangerous properties of any explosive nuclear equipment or nuclear part of that equipment
- War and public disorder: Any loss, damage or liability caused by civil commotion, riot, strike, war, mutiny, military uprising, martial law, rebellion, revolution, any act in protest against any State, Government or Government body.
